

IRISH MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY (IMS)

- 2019-2020: First female society president Prof. Pauline Mellon.
- 2020: Pauline Mellon joined the EWM.
- 2020: IMS endorsed the EWM open letter on the Corona Crisis.
- 2020-2021: Male president; Committee of the Society made of 12 members; 5 female members.
- 2021: I joined the IMS committee; engaging with the Society to improve the participation of Ireland to the EWM.

THE UNIVERSITY OF LIMERICK

- Athena SWAN (Scientific Women's Academic Network) Charter: established in the U.K.
- University of Limerick: holds the Athena SWAN Bronze medal.
- First female president in Ireland at the University of Limerick: Prof. Kerstin Mey
- Department of Mathematics and Statistics: one of the first departments to hold the Athena Swan Bronze medal.
- Department holds a SALI (Senior Academic Leadership Initiative) Chair in Data Science and Statistical Learning.
- 20 SALI posts in Ireland created by the Higher Education Authority (HEA) targeting at addressing gender under-representation at senior academic levels.
- SALI chair at the University of Limerick is in Genomics and Biomedical Sciences.
