EWM report for Finland 2022-2024

Gender equality index

In the Gender Equality Index 2024¹, Finland scored 74.5 points, which is 3.5 points above the EU score, and which ranked the country on the 8th position in the EU.

Student performance

Regarding student performance assessed in PISA 2022², girls' performance in mathematics was one of the highest among PISA-participating countries and economies. (487 PISA Score, rank 10/80, 2022).

No other official EWM events were organized in Finland, but Aalto University held its colloquium once or twice per year as Nyberg Colloquium, where the aim is to highlight women and other minority speakers. It is named after Kaisa Nyberg, a world-renowned emerita professor of cryptography and a role model for many women mathematicians.

Local EWM members were also actively involved in the association's activities between 2022 and 2024, serving in roles such as treasurer, deputy governor, and board member.
